

# Graphic 45 Gift Frame

Difficulty Rating- Easy **Medium** Hard

## Supplies:

- Sierra Pacific Crafts Frame Blank 9"x7"
- Acrylic Paint
- Ribbon 14"
- Metal Tag with two loops
- Graphic 45 Paper
- Monogram Sticker
- Double stick adhesive
- Tools: Corner Rounder, Paint Brush, Scissors for ribbon, fine grit sand Paper, X-acto



## Directions:

1. Begin by painting the frame in a color that coordinates with your favorite Graphic 45 Paper. Once dry distress the edges using fine grit sand paper
2. Next cut paper 8 1/2" x 6 1/2" what will be slightly tricky is to cut the photo window. Remove the frame back, place the paper on the front side of the frame flip the frame so you are looking at the back side and trace the window. Measure 1/8"-1/4" beyond your traced line and cut using an X-acto. This will allow for the frame base color to show better and emphasize the photo.
3. Round the corners of the paper using a corner rounder
4. Cut another piece of paper that measures 4 1/2" x 6 1/2" for inside photo window. Adhere to the inside of the frame back with adhesive
5. Adhere the larger piece of paper to the front of the frame centering so that the edges show.
6. Tie one end of the ribbon to the tag, wrap ribbon around the frame and knot through the other side of the tag and secure. Add the Monogram and you are finished!
