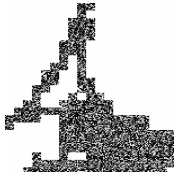


Photo Frame Boxes

Materials:

- Acrylic Paint (Delta Avocado and Americana Burnt Sienna were used)
- Treasure Boxes (Sierra Pacific Crafts #SCH-242-L and #SCH-242-S)
- Foam Brush
- Dry Cloth
- Gel Stain Medium (Delta was used)
- Vinyl Words

Instructions:

To Prepare Treasure Box:

- Following the manufacturer's instruction for Gel Stain Medium, mix equal parts of Gel Stain to your choice of acrylic paint color.
- Mix well.
- Spot test the color. If you would like a more transparent look add more Gel Stain Medium.
- Using a foam brush apply to a clean, dry surface. Allow to dry. If you desire a darker color add another layer until you achieve desired results.

Once the Treasure Box has dried completely you may leave as is or add your favorite vinyl words or phrases.

Photo Frame Boxes
