

BEADED CANDLEHOLDER

Difficulty Rating- **Easy** Medium Hard

Supplies:

- 22-gauge beading wire
- Glass or plastic beads in desired colors/shapes/sizes
- Glass votive candleholder
- Hot-glue gun and hot-glue sticks



Directions:

1. Cut a piece of wire approximately 36 inches long.
2. Place one bead on the end of the wire threading the wire through the bead a second time to secure.
3. String beads on wire as desired, securing the placement. If you desire more length, simply cut and bead an extra length of wire.
4. Secure one end of beaded wire with glue at the top edge of the candleholder.
5. Wrap the beaded wire around the candleholder, securing with glue about every inch.

Two More Ideas....

1. To cover a larger candleholder with beaded wire, simply make several lengths and glue in the same manner as for the small votive candleholder.
2. Try this same idea using miscellaneous jewelry findings, shells, and shank buttons.
